Description:

The paediatric nursing program as an academic experience gives students the opportunity to be in direct contact with the child population, developing primary health care strategies. These strategies include education programs for vulnerable groups, their families, and caretakers, in the case they are in children centers they would also work with the academic staff y personnel at the institution.
