#### Discipline:

#### Duration:

Take a course independently for one 5-week period or enroll in the complete 15-week Spanish Immersion Season. Spanish Immersion Season coincides with the begining and ending of ULACIT's quarterly academic periods

Each Spanish Immersion Level Course spans five weeks, covering 45 contact hours through 3-hour classes 3 times per week, on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.

### **Description:**

Enroll in our Spanish Immersion Program consisting of three Spanish Level Courses offered every academic period. Personalized spanish lessos also available for students with a language profficiency B1 or above. At the end of the program, students will receive an accredited transcript of grades.

Develop Spanish language proficiency in a short span of time through a culturally relevant learning immersion experience, the content of each individual course will get you acquainted with three perspectives of Costa Rica's national identity:

Course 1 - Introductory Spanish - Community and Culture: in this course you will deepen your knowledge on the culture and communities of Costa



Rica while acquiring fundamental Spanish proficiency skills such as learning basic words and expressions used regularly, understand commonly used words, names, and simple phrases, participate in short functional conversations, ask and answer simple questions about topics of immediate need or common matters and write short grammatically correct sentences.

Course 2 - Low Beginner Spanish - Biodiversity: in this course you will acquire low beginner Spanish language competencies by learning about the biodiversity, natural resources, and national nature parks, in short, the ecosystemic wealth of Costa Rica. At the end of the course, it is expected for students to fully understand the main ideas in everyday conversations, read and comprehend short and simple texts, spontaneously participate in simple casual conversations, and write with basic property about various topics using simple grammatical structures in the present, past and future tense.

Course 3 - High Beginner Spanish - History, Democracy and Politics: in this course you will acquire high beginner Spanish language competencies by learning about Costa Rica's history, and it's democratic and political life. At the end of the course, it is expected for students to read and generally understand news articles related to contemporary problems, participate in a conversation with some fluency and spontaneity, explain a point of view on a topic and write clear and detailed simple texts.

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
